Arms of Love Philippines was officially recognized by their government on January 16, 2001.

When our Filipino registration, license and accreditation was processed we began to welcome children who were at-risk, orphaned, abused, abandoned, exploited, neglected, disadvantaged and victims of violence. Over the last 18 years, we have cared for 81 children in our children's home through our residential protection program. By

God's grace we have celebrated 8 university graduates and 9 vocational/technical school graduates. Children have been given hope and another chance at life. Our Executive Director, Jess Mora, was making her annual visit during this special celebration.

We are thankful for the blessings, and we are eager to continue rescuing and raising children.

Nicaragua Community Development Program 6 YEARS OF BLESSINGS



Six years ago we barely knew what we were getting ourselves into! We only knew there was great need in our neighborhood and that we were being asked to step up. The results of our community efforts have been nothing short of miraculous, and it's changing the lives of desperate children and families.

Let us introduce to Geovanny, an active participant of the program since it was founded on March 1st, 2013. He was a shy child and his face revealed deep sadness and disappointment. Geovanny wouldn't play with the other kids, he would only isolate. Like many of the kids in our residential care, he was abandoned by his parents. Geovanny has been raised by his grandparents, who are quite elderly and have struggled to care for him. His academics, hygiene and health showed the struggles

at home.

At Arms of Love, Geovanny was now receiving consistent meals and tutoring. His attitude began to change, suddenly he was becoming enthusiastic and outgoing. Additionally, part of the program was providing counseling and support for the grandparents to help improve Geovanny's home life. In 2017 they would complete an application for a housing remodel, which was granted and completed in collaboration with one of our service teams.

The results are clear. Geovanny is healthy, joyful, respectful, self-confident and studious. He has big dreams for the future and wants to help his family. Stories like this can only happen with the generous support of donors and volunteers. Thank you for directly helping us change lives!
